
REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Classes will be filled using a lottery system. Please complete the registration forms, and place them in the SCA Mailbox in an envelope marked: SCA - AFTER THE BELL. Please get these forms in ASAP.

1. For accounting purposes, **please make a separate check for each child registered**. Course fees are listed with each class selection. Please make all checks payable to GWL-SCA.
2. Enrollment fees are NON-REFUNDABLE, apart from a course cancellation. If a course is cancelled once the program begins, the fee will be refunded proportionately upon request.

Unfortunately, if a class is cancelled due to a school closing (snow, storm, etc.), there will be NO make-up class or refunds offered.

3. We will ONLY notify parents whose child has not been registered in his/ her first-choice course. If you do not hear from us, **check our website for confirmation** of your child's enrollment in his/her first choice. If your first course choice has reached maximum enrollment, you will be enrolled in your second course choice. If you do not have a second choice, your payment will be returned.



4. It is the parent's responsibility to provide the school with a **Change in Going-Home Arrangement Form** on each day their child attends an After the Bell class.
5. A monitor will take attendance, make any necessary phone calls, and supervise the hallways. If your child is not in the class at the time of attendance, a phone call will be made promptly to the number(s) listed on the enrollment form. Please make sure you provide a phone number where you can be reached while classes are in session.

DISMISSAL: Students must be picked up at the **PORTICO NEAREST THE AUDITORIUM** at 3:45 pm. Children who have not been picked up by 3:45 will wait for their parent in the Before/After School Care Program held in the cafeteria. Late pick-ups will result in a late charge of \$5.00 per child payable on that day and excessive late pick-ups may cause the child to be dropped from the program.


Grades: 3-5


INTRODUCTION to PAINTING

RUSSIAN for YOUNG BEGINNERS

VIDEO GAME MAKER




BRIXOLOGY
