-Thank you to Tina Kontorouhas for making the Talent Show a fun night for everyone. Tina thanked Lisa Whalen for her help and support in rehearsals and running the event. Tina has volunteered to run the Talent Show again next year. Thank you to the 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Committee who provided concessions at the Talent Show and to Adrienne Daley for taking photographs.

-Thank you to Corri Wolf for running the Science Fair. Bridget said that we did not have a huge turnout for this event and that we are going to consider holding the Science Fair next year on a week night.

-Bridget thanked Laura and the rest of the Executive Board for running Family Fun Night this year. Laura thanked Mrs. Finder and Mrs. Jacobs for helping us find faculty volunteers. Our 50/50 raffle winner was Mr. Weisman, who generously donated his winnings to the SCA.

-The C.R.E.W. Closing Ceremony will be held this Thursday in the Auditorium and parents are invited to watch the performances. Thank you to Joan Meaney for organizing and running this event.

**New Business:**

-Thank you to Suzanne Gaeta and Nicki Tedesco, who are the new Co-chairs of the Citizen's Awareness Committee.

-Cathy O'Brien and Terry Sheridan, Co-chairs of the 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Dance Committee, reported that the fundraising for this event is finished. The Co-chairs said that the very successful 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Book Fair, various sales that were held, and a contribution from the SCA, account for all of the money that has been raised for this event. The Chairs both stated that while traditionally the SCA has contributed up to \$2,000 for this event, the Committee will work very hard to keep this amount as low as possible. The price of tickets for the dance is \$20. Each child's ticket comes with a DVD at no additional cost. The Chairs also stated that there will be four paid chaperones provided by the District so that parents do not have to attend if they can't or don't wish to do so. They do, however, anticipate that most children will be accompanied by one parent.

-The Glenwood Gallery 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Art Show will take place on April 16<sup>th</sup> from 7-8 p.m. This event will help support the 4<sup>th</sup> grade trip to Carnegie Hall. The co-chairs for this event are Dawn Walton and Heather DiBenedetto. The students will each have three pieces of art on display. The price of admission is \$10 per family. The 4<sup>th</sup> grade parents will donate drinks and appetizers. Dawn said that Heather will be sending out an e-mail this week to ask for volunteers. Dawn will follow up with the class parents.

-The SCA Board is making an effort to introduce themselves to incoming Kindergarten parents during the Kindergarten screening and also at the upcoming Kindergarten Orientations.

-The Nominating Committee chair, Lisa Vizza reported that the committee is still in need of about 8 volunteers. We are looking for candidates to fill the position of Co-President, Vice President and Recording Secretary.

-The Accounting Review Committee is going to meet with Jackie to review 10 random transactions. They are also going to review the SCA's by-laws.

-The Book Fair will be held during the week of April 12<sup>th</sup>. Julia Venturino and Paula Genet will run this event. The theme this year will be "Book Fair Diner", and Starbucks is going to donate coffee for Family Night. This book fair is not a fundraiser; a 20% discount is passed along to families.

-The Nutrition Committee reports that there will be a film at the Sea Cliff School this evening called "Two Angry Moms". The film is about two mothers in Westchester County trying to improve their school's lunch program. Interested parents are encouraged to come and see the movie and be a part of this committee which is supported by Dr. Melnick.

-The next date for the Lord and Taylor fundraiser is May 6<sup>th</sup>. We need to sell 50 tickets in order to qualify to receive a percentage back from Lord and Taylor. Tickets will be sold through May 5<sup>th</sup>.
